Hike Description: Weaver Mountain Crested Saguaro Cluster is a meandering hike among many types or desert fauna. The special interest of this hike is the many crested Saguaros that have flourished there. It is estimated that crested Saguaros occur only one in 200,000. This area has nearly 15, which is very rare. The hike is on two track jeep dirt roads. There is optional climbing of the hills if one desires to get closer to the specimens.
