HIKE DESCRIPTION FORM

Hike Name: Yavapai Pipeline Canyon/Yavapai Lookout

Location: Lake Pleasant Park, Peoria

Hike Description: Yavapai Lookout Hike at Lake Pleasant is an out and back hike with a beautiful view of Lake Pleasant and the surrounding mountains. The hike begins at the Pipeline Canyon Day Use and Trailhead Parking Area at Lake Pleasant Regional Park. We will take the Pipeline Canyon trail to the Yavapai Point Trail which takes us to Yavapai Lookout. We will return on the Yavapai Point Trail to the .1-mile Connector Trail which connects to the Pipeline Canyon Trail returning us to the Pipeline Canyon Day Use and Trailhead Parking Area.

Rating: Easy to mostly moderate

Type: In-Out

Trail Name(s): Pipeline and Yavapai Point Trails

Length – Miles and Time: 5.7 mile

Trailhead Start and End: North entrance of Lake Pleasant Park

Elevation Change: 600'

Travel Directions:

From SCF drive east on the Sun Valley Parkway to Hwy. Loop 303 North. Take Exit 131 on to the Lake Pleasant Parkway and turn left heading north. Drive to the Lake Pleasant Rd. and turn left heading west on Highway 74. Drive to North Castle Hot Springs Road and turn right. Turn right onto Lake Pleasant Access Rd, pay \$7 at booth, or use your Maricopa county parks pass. Follow that to N Park Rd which will end in a parking lot for the trailhead.

Travel Time: Approximately 1 hour

Parking: Yes, there is a large parking area
