Hike Name: Thunderbird Conservation Park, Cholla Trail & Coach Trail

Location: Thunderbird Conservation Park, Glendale, Arizona

Hike Description: A gradual, rocky, stony assent to the top of a small mountain with good views of the Valley. It is more of a semi urban hike to begin with and it transforms to a more desert like setting as the hike goes around and up the mountain.
