Hike Description: The National Park Service offers a ranger led hike to the Upper Cliff Dwellings of the Tonto National Monument adjacent to Lake Roosevelt. Reservations can be made for Fri – Mon from November – April. The maximum group size is 15. The UPPER CLIFF Dwellings Trail has several steps, some slick rocks, and some loose gravel. The hike starts from the visitor center. Check in is 9:45 am at the Visitor Center, hikes start at 10:00 am. The Lower Cliff Dwellings are accessible daily to the public and are a short hike from the Visitor Center.

Take Loop 101 Exit 41 to E Shea Ave. Take a right onto E Shea Ave and continue through Fountain Hills to AZ 87 Highway (Bee Line Highway). Turn left on AZ 87 toward Payson. Take AZ 188 Highway exit and turn right (south). Follow AZ 188 south to entrance of Tonto National Monument (approx 35 miles) on the right.
