Hike Name: Waterfall Trail Hike, White Tank Mountains

Travel Directions: Drive the Sun Valley Parkway (east) to Cotton Lane, turn right (south) on to Cotton Lane. Drive to Olive Ave. and turn right (west) at Olive Ave. and drive to the Park entrance. Once in the park, follow the White Tank Mountain Road to the Waterfall Canyon Road. Turn left onto Waterfall Canyon Road and look for the sign for Waterfall Trail on the left. Parking is at that point.
